Record Monthly Boardings

January 2006 saw a record number of passengers fly out of the Sioux Falls Regional Airport. A total of 30,348 passengers boarded flights during the month, besting the previous best for a January set last year by 2,455 passengers.

Northwest Airlines and Northwest Airlink led with 13,027 passengers for a 42.9% share. United Express was second with 11,092 for a 36.5% share, then Allegiant with 11.1%, Delta Connection/Comair with 4.7% and America West Express at 3.7%. There were 287 passengers on charter flights.
